Citi-Urban Management is interested in using the technology of Clean Air Zone on a project considered for Air Force SBIR Phase II funding award.


All modern indoor air spaces are polluted and contaminated to one degree or another, there are many studies confirming this. This “bad air” is responsible for poor health, sickness, a lack of energy and ability to maintain a high cognitive state. Current mechanical and filter-based systems have proven ineffective in actually removing contaminants from the air space. Pollution in the form of VOCs (Volatile Organic Compounds) and Particulates in the form of unwanted biologicals, dust and dander represent a huge and on-going challenge. Odors and smells exiting from these contaminants are often offensive to clients.

1. Citi-Urban Management supports a potential AFWERX/AFVentures Phase II Competitive Performance project with Clean Air Zone (CAZ) in mitigating against all of the above contaminants. We understand that CAZ’s bio-mechanical system improves over time, conventional mechanical systems degrade over time, they just don’t work well. They offer a biological approach to a biological problem. The mission impact of this project on Citi-Urban Management and the Air Force will be the superior ability to help take control of the air space leading to improved health and performance. Their system is unique to the marketplace. They not only capture and remove contaminants, but their biological system also destroys and neutralizes them on-site, they don’t just aggregate them there-by creating waste and additional expense.
